Representatives report

The work being done by the head teacher and staff at Cwm Banwy was amazing. 46% of pupils were in school but each day saw a different cohort of pupils depending on the commitments of parents. All homes had access to digital machines with one family without internet connections. A music and animation practitioner and a dance practitioner had been appointed to help with these areas of the curriculum. It was agreed to send a card of appreciation to the school.
